- **Optional SAT** (1020-1230)
- **Optional ACT** (22-27)
- **Optional personal statement**

SCHOLARSHIPS

Students with a strong academic profile outside of these criteria may also be considered for scholarships.

Scholarship	Amount	Eligibility	Requirements
Presidential Scholarship	Up to \$48,000 total Up to \$12,000 per year	3.75/4.0 GPA	Highly competitive; must submit scholarship form by December 15 to be considered
University Scholarship	Up to \$40,000 total Up to \$10,000 per year	3.5/4.0 GPA; Traditionally underrepresented population or first generation	Highly competitive; must submit scholarship form by December 15 to be considered
Redbird Academic Scholarship	Up to \$20,000 total \$1,000-\$5,000 per year	3.0/4.0 GPA	Eligible freshmen will automatically receive this award

Qualified incoming freshmen should apply for admission no later than November 1 for best consideration.

Other scholarships include our McLean County Full Tuition Scholarship, Legacy Scholarship, International Baccalaureate Scholarship, and Achievement Scholarship.
